As a school, we will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 7th March. We have lots of exciting activities planned for the children which are detailed below. As always, we invite the children to dress up as a character if they'd like but if not, some other options are to come dressed as a word or even just make a clue card for their favourite character and wear that instead!

This year we have arranged the opportunity for all children to visit the local library. If children already have a library card, then they can bring this with them on the day their class is visiting so they can also borrow a book. If children haven't signed up for a card, they will still be able to visit the library but they unfortunately won't be able to borrow a book.

We will also have lots of other fun activities for the children to take part in such as decorating their classroom doors in the style of a book, drawing their teacher as their favourite character and having a whole day off normal timetable to explore and enjoy a book with their teacher. Children will also receive their World Book day token which can be redeemed for their free book.
