On Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February at 2.30pm we will be offering a workshop for parents where we will talk in more detail about the end of Key Stage 2 assessments that will take place **Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup>- Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2023**. This is a great opportunity for you to come and see what is involved in the assessments and ask any questions to staff that you may have.
