

Year 6 Visit to Black Country Museum

On Wednesday 26th September, Year 6 went to the Black Country Museum as part of our learning about the Victorians.

The first thing we did was to visit the school. There were high windows in the school so that the children wouldn't get distracted during lessons. If any of the children were naughty they would get whipped. One of the lessons they did was to learn the alphabet backwards. We also discovered that they used to have a Back Board that would be used if children didn't sit up straight.

After visiting the school we visited the Gregory Hardware store where we were told about the products and prices of things. We found out that they used to sell Carbolic Soap that would've been used to wash everything from people to clothes.

We visited a few varieties of Victorian style houses that are very different to our houses now. They used to have a pot called a Guzunder that they all wee'd in at night so they didn't have to go outside. This would go under the bed, which is where it got its name.


Life in Victorian times was very different to our lives now, although there are a lot of similarities. Schools are very different as children are no longer whipped for punishment.


