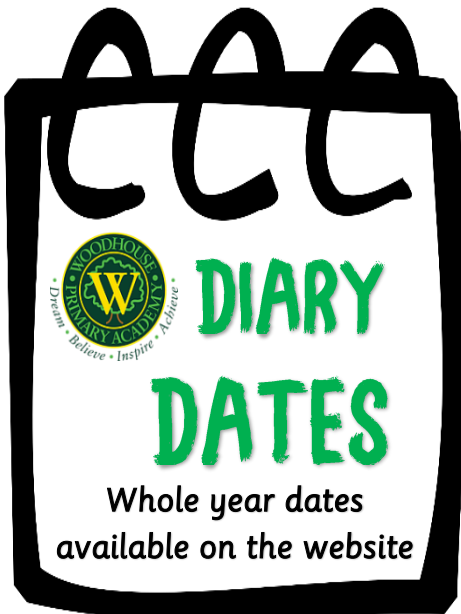

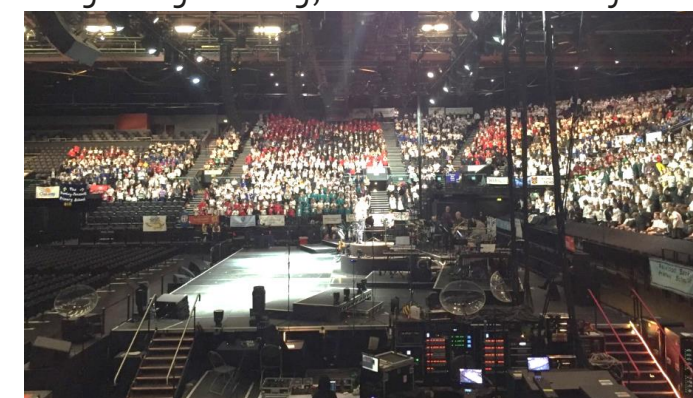
Arts Ambassadors

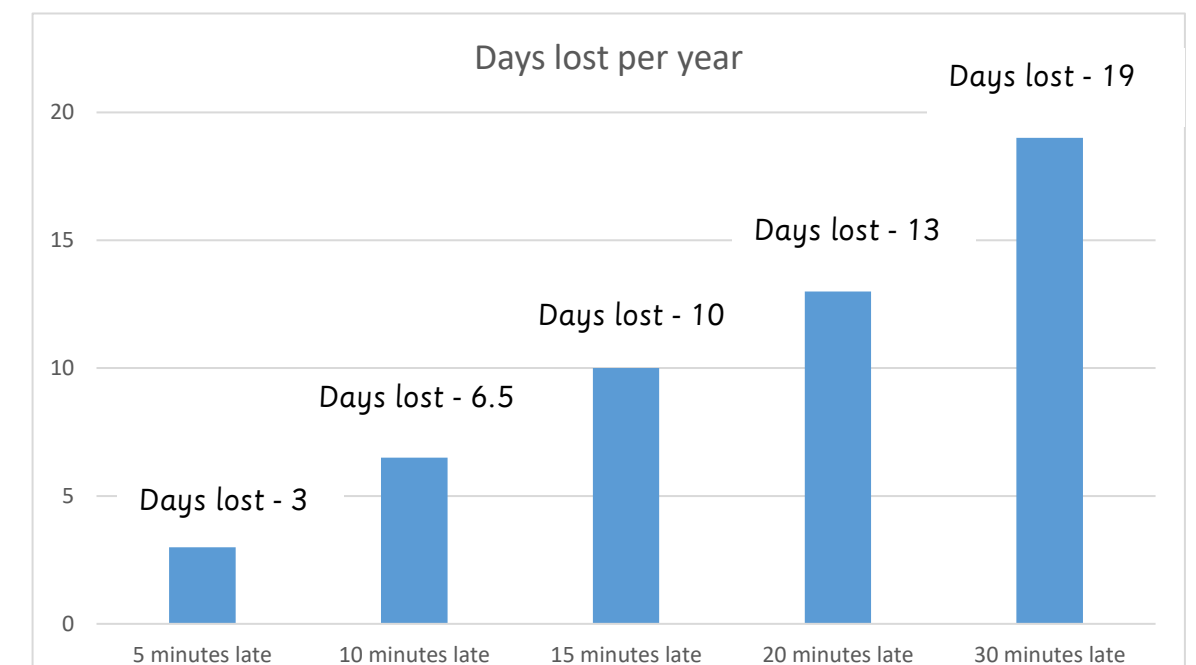
