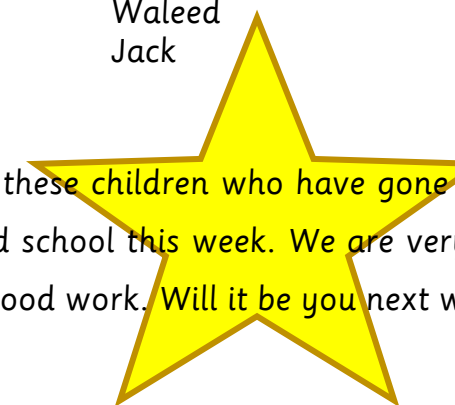

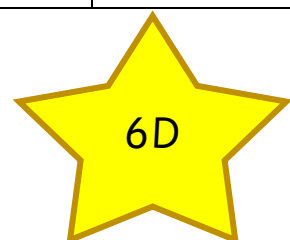

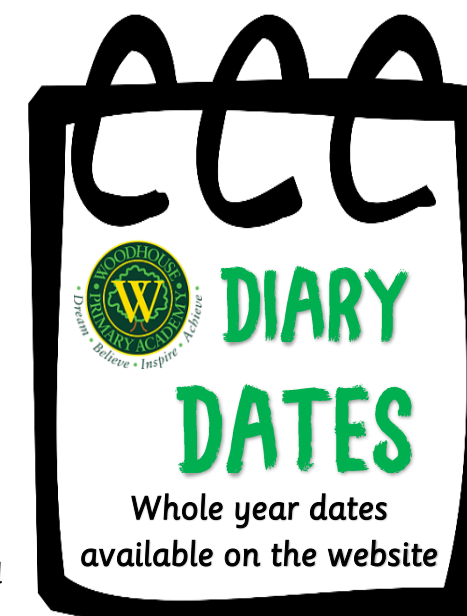

Year One's Chocolate Bonanza

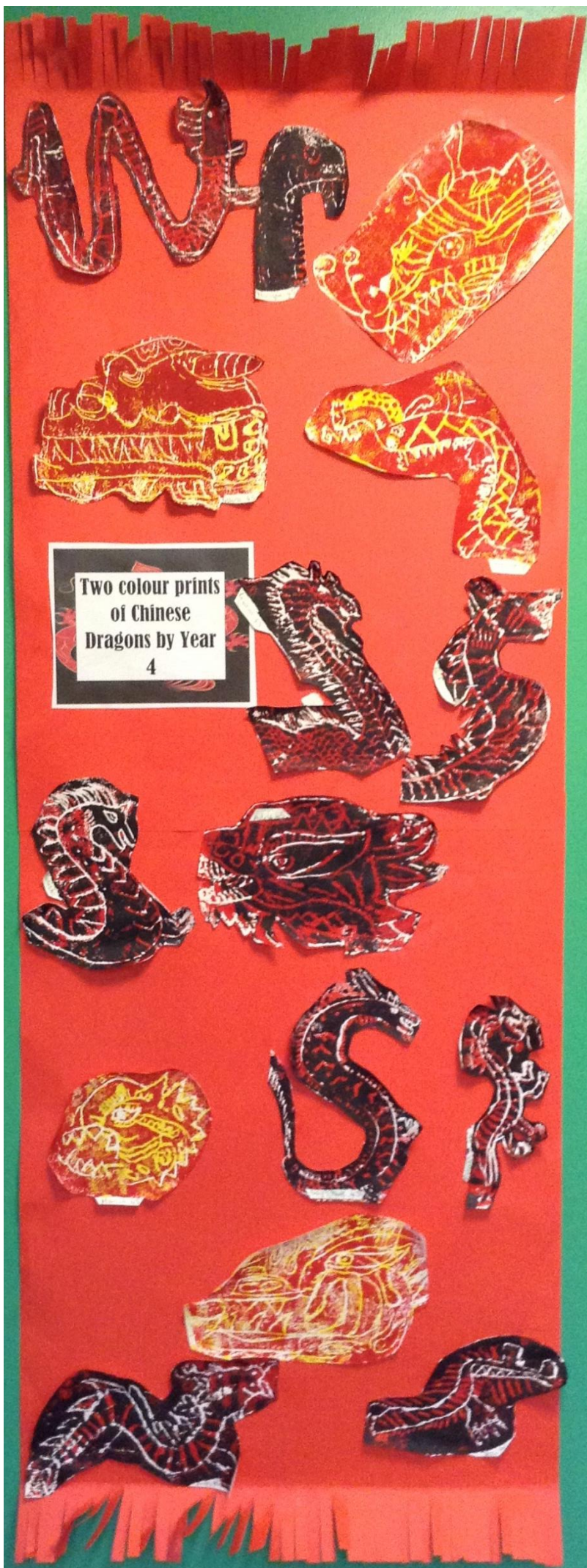
Year One bought their Topic work to life this week as they visited Cadbury World to explore how the Cadbury family first established the Bournville chocolate factory and how it evolved into what it is today.
