

## **Rainbow Room Painting**






Rainbow Room have had great fun outside this week with the paint.

Everyone should be able to get from A to B in a safe, direct and timely manner. Be it on foot, mobility scooter, bike or in a vehicle.


## Join our campaign to update pedestrian wait and crossing times across Harborne and Quinton!
