Easter Bonnets



As a partnership, we have all signed up to LetsLocalise - a company designed to bring business support to schools across the UK.



At Woodhouse, we have developed this relationship and it provides the exciting Grow@School project utilising the vertical towers in each of our academies. The LetsLocalise platform is a brilliant way of gaining additional support in our schools, and this week we received some amazing support from the London Stock Exchange Group. All our many phonics groups in Year 1 and Year 2 now have a brilliant caddy for keeping resources together, ensuring Fred and our magnetic boards remain special friends! We also had two great flipchart easels, to be used with groups around school. A set of brand-new state of the art 23" Dell Monitors will enable better display around school, and a stack of pens and papers will give us an additional free resource. What does your school need right now? Perhaps there is a business out there keen to help and support you.



After introducing the clothing and uniform bank in the Autumn term, we have now rearranged and improved access to our stock. There are all necessary uniform items for boys or girls of every age and size, with a mix of pre-loved and brand-new donated clothing.

Alongside the uniform, we have school shoes, trainers, wellies and pumps - again, in a wide range of sizes. Our new clothing rails mean that the impressive array of outdoor coats can be properly displayed and can be better selected from. Hats, scarves, gloves and bags complete the offerings.



Since setting up the uniform and clothing bank, we have been inundated with support from families in school, with the community at Woodhouse committed to helping others in this way. We are excited about what else we can do to help, and will continue to grow this provision.
