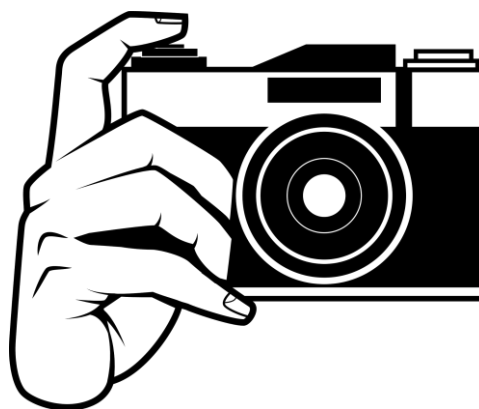
School Class Photos

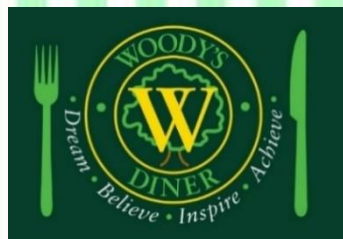

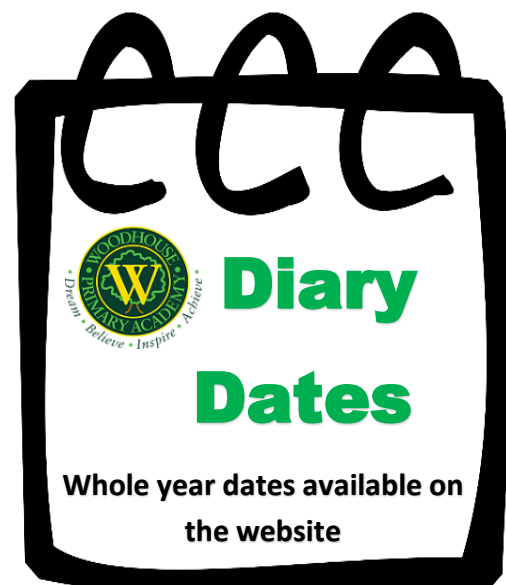
