

Dear Mr Wilson,

It was a pleasure to recently learn that Woodhouse Primary Academy has achieved the Inclusive School Award with Flagship status. I wish to extend my congratulations, and my thanks, to all at your school for this wonderful achievement.

Reading in the report how Woodhouse 'acknowledges the uniqueness of each child and commits to investing in them individually, ensuring they are known, loved, and well-taught' is, in my view, an approach all of us in society should adopt.

I am especially impressed by the inclusiveness of young people who have enrolled at Woodhouse for whom English is not their first language. The report references a child from Afghanistan who has only been in the UK for two years and who, when they first enrolled could not say '*Hi*' but who now can speak English fluently and appears to be thriving.

Further testimonies allude to how teachers live up to the Academy's aims with children expressing how they 'love everything, especially the teachers' while others explain how they feel 'really happy' at school.

You and your staff have my heartfelt gratitude for your achievements and dedication to your profession and young people you teach. I look forward to seeing what the future brings for Woodhouse Academy.


