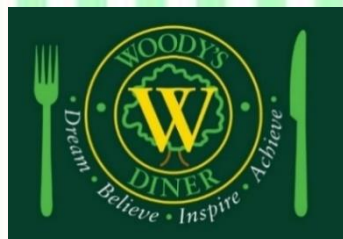

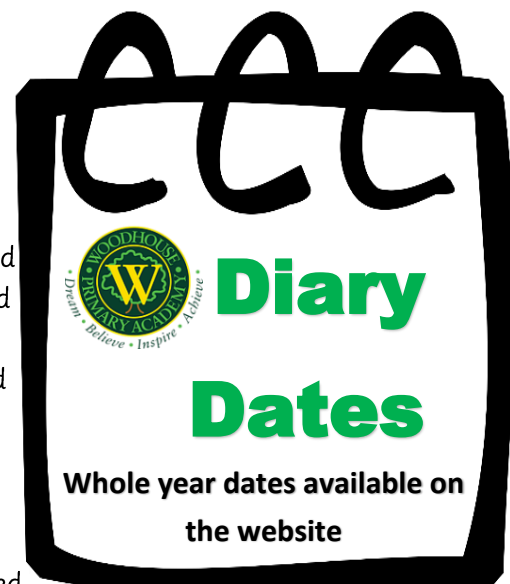

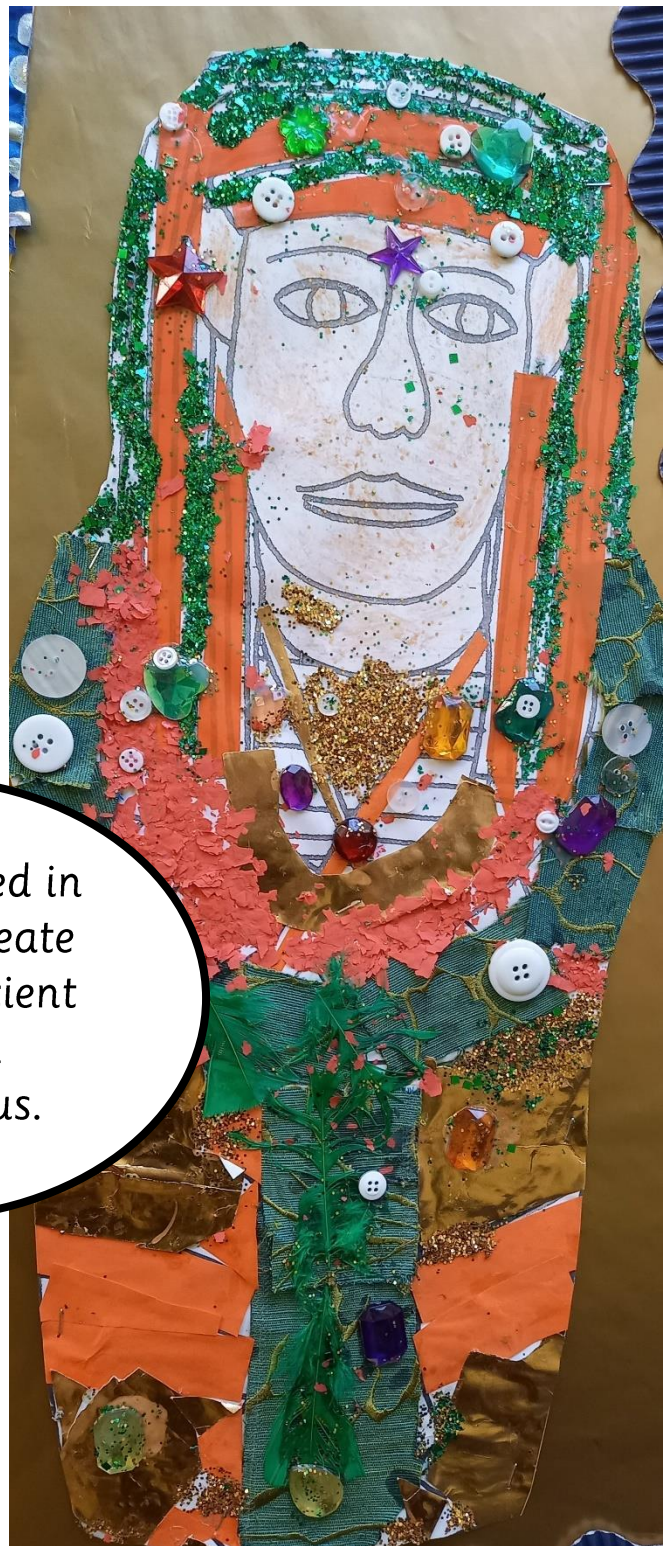
## Attendance Challenge Countdown
