It's Big Garden Birdwatch weekend. Get counting!

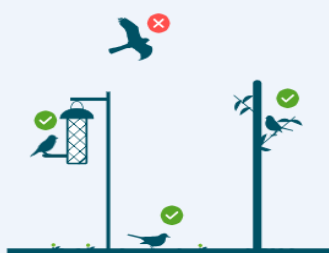
How to take part

- 1 Get your free guide and stock up on supplies, with 15% off and free delivery on food and feeders at the RSPB shop.



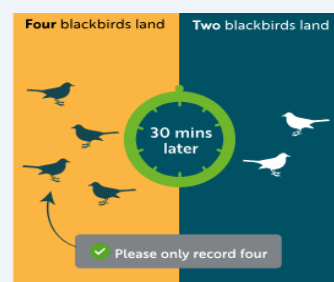
Choose an hour between

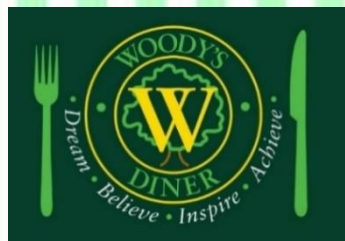

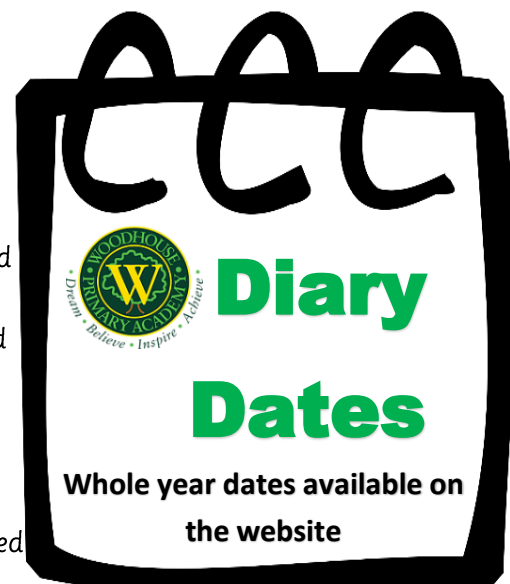
