## Principles and Aims

**Due to the COVID-19 pandemic there are additional procedures, routines and expectations in place. This is to ensure that school runs smoothly and safely for as long as national or local restrictions apply.**

WPA staff, parents, carers and children will work together so that school continues to be a safe and happy environment for all.

### Woodhouse Primary Academy will...

- Develop clear routines and procedures that will enable school to be as safe as possible, including comprehensive risk assessments
- Communicate these routines and expectations to families clearly, including any changes through the school website and text messaging service
- Inform parents and carers of any suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19 within class bubbles and take appropriate action
- Adapt our curriculum to support all children, being mindful of their mental health and well-being
- Ensure that children are reminded of the school behaviour policy and aware of additional expectations
- Continue to be consistent in our approach to rewards and sanctions, including the use of fixed term exclusions if absolutely necessary

## Parents and Carers

### In order to support my child in the return to school I will...

- Adhere to the times and gates when dropping off and collecting my child
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school and we will self-isolate pending the outcome of a test. I will inform school of the outcome of any testing.
- Collect my child from school immediately if they show any symptoms of COVID-19
- Understand that I cannot enter the school site without arranging it, via telephone or email, first
- Regularly talk to my child about the need to follow any new routines or rules and the need for good hygiene practices
- Understand that if my child is deliberately not following school's COVID-19 rules and procedures sanctions, including fixed term exclusion, could be used.
- Support all school staff in implementing the COVID-19 rules and procedures which have been designed to keep the entire school community safe
- Ensure that my child does not bring any additional items to school, other than a coat, lunchbox or drinks bottle
