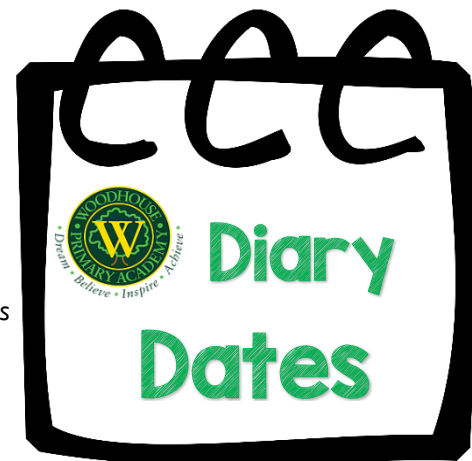

To mark 100 years since the end of the First World War, we have held some very special remembrance activities this week.

We had an assembly on Monday in which we discussed why the poppy is used as a symbol of remembrance and we shared some stories and poetry about remembrance.

On Thursday we used our work books to create a large poppy in the playground. The finished article is amazing. On Friday we held our own remembrance service where Mr Wilson said a few words, we held a minutes silence and then Mr Wilson played The Last Post. It was a very moving service.

We have had lots of children asking all sorts of questions this week about remembrance and sharing their own stories of family members or just coming to say they have their poppies on and they are remembering.



We are proud to be supporting the Royal British Legion again this year and will be selling poppies, pencils, rulers, rubbers & wrist bands. All proceeds go to the charity.
