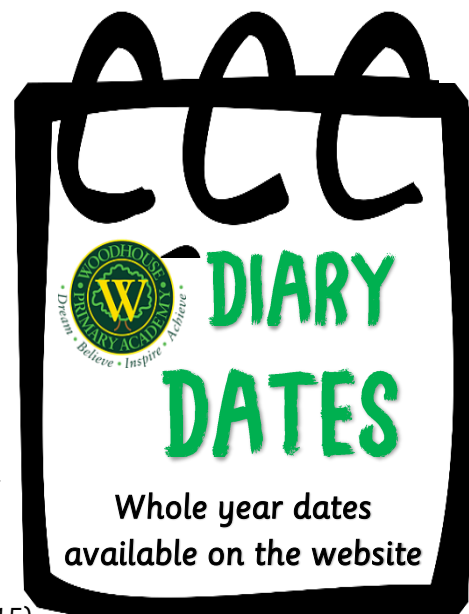

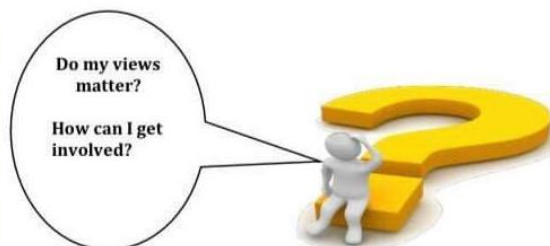
Congratulations to **6WS** who had the best class attendance for last week. We had 99 lates last week across all year groups. These, no matter how small, are lost learning time.
