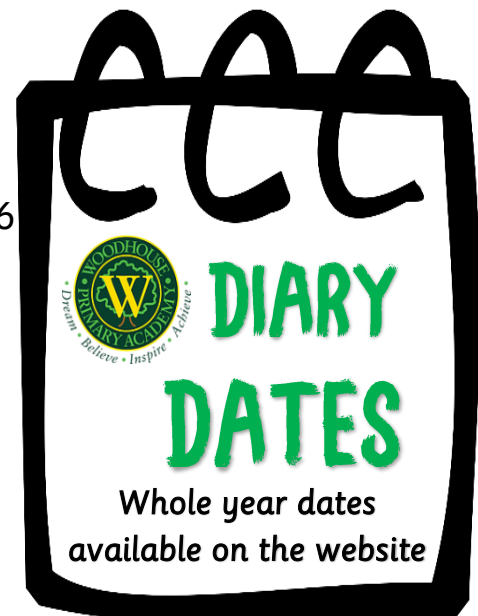

## **FOOD ALLERGIES**

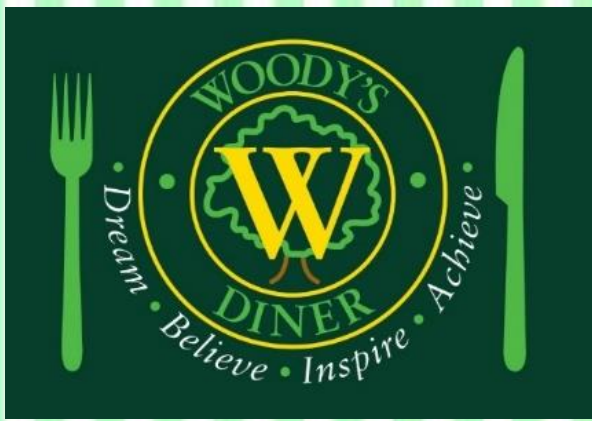
We have been updating our records in school and ensuring our dietary and allergy information is up to date.
